## **Recycled Planter**

You can be a good steward by recycling or reusing things. Supplies: empty bottle, can, or cup; acrylic paint; a paintbrush; pebbles; soil; and plants or seeds

1. Remove any labels.

- 2. Ask an adult to help cut the bottle down to about four inches.
- 3. Apply your favorite paint color on the outside.
- 4. Once it's dry, add a layer of pebbles to the bottom of the bottle.
- 5. Put in soil and add the plant or seeds.
- 6. Water your plant and watch it grow!
